Scope of Explosive Hazard in Libya

In Libya, the scale and complexity of explosive hazard contamination in recovered areas is huge.

Explosive hazards (mines, ERW and IEDs) pose an immediate threat to the lives of thousands of returnees and those delivering humanitarian assistance and hinder stabilisation and reconstruction efforts.



LibMAC and Humanitarian Mine Action partners will take all necessary measures to ensure safe access and freedom of movement by reducing the impact of explosive hazards.






Implementation of Stabilization Plans

The overall objective is to assist stabilization efforts and humanitarian activities supporting the return of displaced people to areas previously under ISIL occupation, specifically to:

- **Address the need to provide MA response**
- **Survey newly retaken areas to assess the impact of threats posed by explosive hazards;**
- **Conduct threat impact assessments of residential areas and priority locations;**
- **React to explosive hazard (clearance);**
- **Initiate and carry out intensive risk education activities ; and**
- **Enhance the national clearance capacity.**





Activities and Achievements


In Sirte, 32 residential areas and priority locations for the construction of critical infrastructure and utilities, including electricity, water, schools and health care centres were surveyed by LibMAC and 3F NTS Teams.





Activities and Achievements

In Benghazi, 18 suspected contaminated areas for critical infrastructure development have been surveyed, including water and electricity sites, schools, hospitals and health care centers were surveyed by the Forensics, NSA and Military Engineering NTS Teams.



Challenges

- ❖ High level of contamination
- ❖ The ongoing conflict and the continued presence of ISIL
- ❖ Convincing IDPs to delay their return
- ❖ Timely security and access to priority areas continue to be problematic
- ❖ Limited ERW and IEDD capacity in Libya
- ❖ Vast geographical area
- ❖ Shortfall in governmental and international support
